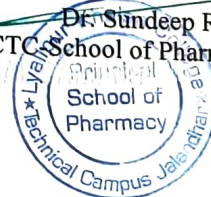
Objectives of the Cell:

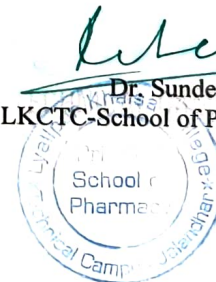

Gender Sensitization Cell Circular

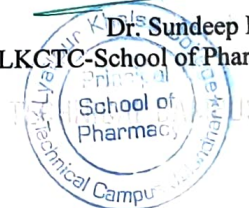
